NAVAL COURT MARTIAL
WITH THE NETHERLANDS FORCES IN THE EAST

SUMMARY OF SENTENCE
(multum in parvo)

By sentence of the Naval Court Martial with the Netherlands Forces in the East, passed on the 8th of October 1943 and delivered at the Court's Session on the same day,

HENRY KELDER

age : 23 years; born at : Rijssen (Holland)
serving as : Sergeant-pilot in the Air-Arm of the Royal Netherlands East-Indian Army;

has been found guilty of:
I. Conspiring to commit military treason in time of war;
II. Conspiring to desert to the enemy;


under sections :

- 1, 6, 23, 35, 49, 63(1^o), 77, 100 and 105 of the Code of Military Criminal Law,
- 28(3^o), 31, 57, 80 of the Code of Criminal Law,
- 185, 189 and 197 of the Code for the Administration of Justice,
- 86 of the Code adapting Military Criminal and Disciplinary Law,

was sentenced to :

twenty years imprisonment, less period under remand aggregating 332 days,
dismissal from the military service,
deprived of the right to serve with the armed forces,
deprived of the right to vote for and of being eligible to any Constituent or Legislative Assembly for a period of twenty-five years.

In pursuance of the powers vested in me, I, W.H. Vermeer, Advocate General and Prosecuting Officer to the Netherlands Naval Court Martial order that the imprisonment of

HENRY KELDER

shall take effect from the nineteenth day of October 1943, and in consideration of the time served by him under remand aggregating three hundred and thirty two days, the said imprisonment, unless remission be granted, shall terminate on the twenty-first second day of November in the year nineteen hundred and sixty two, further that the period of twenty five years, referred to in the final paragraph of the sentence shall end on October 19th 1968.
